LESLIE TURNER studied Criminal Justice and Sociology at UNLV. She has 15 years of experience working with adults, youth, and families directly impacted by systemic racism on various levels. FOLLOWING ARE SEVERAL NEVADA LEGISLATION INITIATIVES. LINKS ARE PROVIDED TO SUBMIT YOUR OPINIONS ON THESE PROPOSALS. **GUN LEGISLATION** - Assembly Bill 286 - ban ghost guns and enforce private property option to ban guns. Still under consideration with additional amendments forthcoming.

This legislation makes it unlawful to manufacture and sell guns using an assembly of parts, commonly referred to as ghost guns that cannot be traced. There is no oversight or laws to prevent this type of product from being sold to anyone.

Also, private property owners, like Las Vegas strip hotels, have an optin to enforce a ban of guns on their property with law enforcement support.

**BAN CAPITAL PUNISHMENT** – Assembly Bill 395 – VOTED OUT OF COMMITTEE – is alive and well for further consideration.

## ASSEMBLY BILL 422 – TOP DOWN MANAGEMENT OF VOTER REGISTRATION DATA

Revises the current data management from County to Sec'y of State control.

AN ACT relating to elections; requiring the Secretary of State to create a centralized database that collects and stores voter preregistration and registration information from all of the counties. Simplifies the data management and improves accurate record keeping.
