The Clark County Election Department needs part-time hourly temporary staff for our counting board for the 2024 Elections. **APPLY NOW!**

When:

- Jan. 17-Feb. 12, 2024 (Presidential Preference Primary Election);
- May 22-June 17, 2024 (Regular Primary Election); and/or
- Oct. 16-Nov. 12, 2024 (General Election).

Where: Clark County Election Dept., 965 Trade Dr., North Las Vegas

Hours: Monday-Thursday, 7:30am-5:30pm, PLUS required overtime as needed, including some weekends and holidays

Pay: \$17.00 per hour, PLUS overtime compensation

Requirements:

BASIC REQUIREMENTS: Ability to stand, sit, and walk around for extended periods; ability to lift at least 25 lbs., and some job duties may require lifting over 50 lbs.; work well as a team member; demonstrate good judgment, communication, and people skills; must remain nonpartisan when working; must attend a mandatory training class and pass a quiz; and must be registered to vote in Clark County, NV.

MUST HAVE FLEXIBILITY WITH: Job duties and enduring long working hours.

MUST PASS: An interview, a drug test, and a background check.
